
Panelist, FSPHP CMO, Dr. Chris Bundy, Participates in

Panelist, Tri-Regulator Symposium

Last week, Dr. Chris Bundy, FSPHP Chief Medical Officer and the Washington Physicians Health Program Executive Medical Director participated in the panel "***Management and Treatment of Licensees***" at the 2025 Tri-Regulator Symposium - 2025 Opioid Regulatory Collaborative Summit in Virginia hosted by the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB), the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP), and the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN).

Other panelists included Nicole L. Chopski, PharmD, ANP, Bureau Chief, Health Professions Bureau, Idaho Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses and Christopher Harlow, PharmD, Executive Director, Kentucky Board of Pharmacy, and was moderated by Katie Templeton, JD, Chair, FSMB.

This session examined the role of licensing boards in managing and treating healthcare professionals with substance use disorders, discussed best practices for identifying and supporting impaired practitioners, and highlighted collaborative approaches to ensure patient safety and support recovery.
